Leadership Conversation Guide – Come and See Confidence

Main Idea

In this week's message, Pastor Dino Rizzo concluded our "Change Your World" series by encouraging us to share the Gospel confidently with a "come and see" approach to those around us. There are so many people who are going through life blind to the truth of God, and they simply need someone to show them Jesus. When we live with a "come and see confidence," our lives compel others to want to know Jesus. When they see how He has changed our lives, they realize He can change theirs, too.
